The Adult Partial Hospital Program at Stormont-Vail West offers intensive outpatient intervention in a structured, supportive day setting. The program operates 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday through Friday for adults with a psychiatric illness.

Clinical Staff:

Taylor Porter, M.D., is the medical director of Stormont-Vail West and oversees the Adult Partial Hospital Program. The on-site ARNP provides the medication evaluation and monitoring throughout the course of the program.

Program Goals:

The Partial Hospital Program is an ideal crisis stabilization alternative to inpatient hospitalization. The program also provides treatment during transition to community living following hospitalization for acute psychiatric illness. When traditional outpatient clinics or office visits can no longer meet a person's clinical needs, this partial program can provide intensive, ambulatory care.

The program provides patients with the skills to transition back to a healthier functioning. Individuals must have a sufficient level of cognitive ability to benefit from this therapeutic program.

Length of Stay:

The Partial Hospital Program is an intense short-term treatment program. Length of stay will depend upon the patient's individual treatment needs.

Group Therapies:

Clients will participate in groups led by licensed staff. The overall goal for group work is to learn new coping strategies and enhance life skills.

Accommodations:

The Partial Hospital Program's separate entrance allows for direct, personal access. Our spacious, home-like atmosphere with windows overlooking several garden patios provides a safe and secure healing environment. Nutritious noon meals are provided in the hospital's cafeteria. We take pride in our warm and caring atmosphere and the individualized treatment we provide. Our staff will be happy to help with admission and can assist with transportation needs.
