The role of the eye bank in giving the gift of sight is often misunderstood.

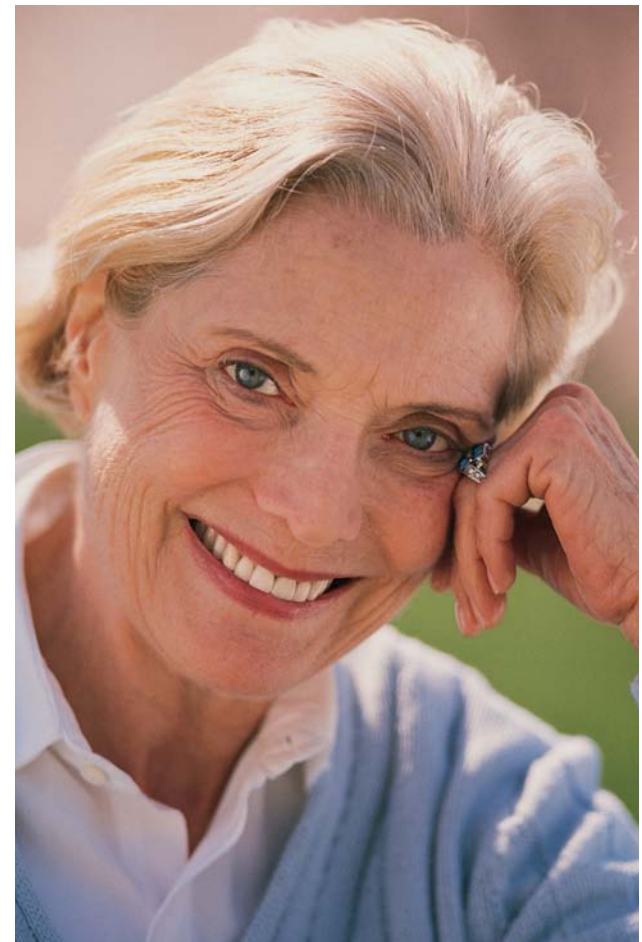
