

About the Cotton-O'Neil Cancer Center

The Cotton-O'Neil Cancer Center, located in the Howard N. Ward, M.D. Medical Building, is a prevention, treatment and research facility. As a division of Stormont-Vail HealthCare, it offers one-stop outpatient medical services for patients, with appointments available with a general surgeon, medical oncologist and radiation oncologist, all in the same location.

In addition, the center houses state-of-the-art cancer diagnostic, staging and treatment technology, an infusion center (chemotherapy) and a clinical research center. There are also ancillary services offered for patients such as genetic counseling, nutritional counseling, social work and pastoral care.

Convenience for Patient and Family

The Cotton-O'Neil Cancer Center was designed with the patient and family in mind. In addition to nearby parking, the one-level center has a covered canopy area for pick up and drop off just outside the front door. Inside there are treatment area options, from private rooms to family rooms, where patients and their families can be together. The center also has an "open treatment" area where patients can be with others others receiving treatment, if they choose.



State-of-the-Art Technology

The latest technology for cancer diagnosis, staging and treatment is located in the Cotton-O'Neil Cancer Center.

The Cotton-O'Neil Cancer Center has the first PET/CT in a 13-county region in northeast Kansas. PET stands for positron emission tomography. CT stands for computed tomography.

With PET/CT capabilities, the equipment simultaneously images and combines the results of two state-of-the-art scanner technologies into a single exam: the highly sensitive PET scan picks up actively growing cancer cells, and the CT scan provides a detailed picture of the inside of your body to reveal the size and shape of abnormal cancerous growths. PET/CT is one of the most powerful tools in cancer diagnosis and staging.



The linear accelerator in the Cotton-O'Neil Cancer Center is an Image-Guided Radiotherapy (IGRT) System.

This system, known as the Trilogy, is a powerful image-guided radiation therapy system that delivers high-dose radiation to even the smallest tumors. The equipment can target an area as small as a pencil point, minimizing the damage
