

**Summary:** A study to evaluate the efficacy and safety of an investigational drug versus atorvastatin in patients with mixed hyperlipidemia.

**Inclusion Criteria:**

- Male or female patients ages 18-80
- LDL 130 or greater
- Triglycerides >150 and less than 500
- Patients currently on statins or other lipid lowering agents are allowed to wash out of current therapy in the early stage of the trial

**Exclusion Criteria:**

- Pregnancy or breast feeding
- Poorly controlled diabetes, HbA1c >8 at screening
- Patients who are currently being treated with a statin or other lipid lowering agents in a high risk cardiac group
- Drug or alcohol abuse
- Poor liver function
- Poor kidney function
- Uncontrolled metabolic diseases
- Heart Failure
- Cardiac Arrhythmias
- Unstable hypertension
- History of MI, coronary bypass surgery, unstable angina within 3 months of screening
- Intermittent use of HRT's
- Systemic Corticosteroids
