

Summary: A randomized, double-blind, placebo controlled study of an investigational drug in treatment of Irritable Bowel Syndrome with Diarrhea.

Inclusion Criteria:

- Age 18-70 years
- Fulfill Rome III criteria for IBS-D and at screening report their usual abdominal pain / discomfort score at no greater than 4 on the scale of 1-6
- Must be able to make entries into a touch tone telephone diary on a daily basis
- Must be willing to abstain from taking rescue medication in the run-in phase
- Must be willing to abstain from alcohol for the treatment phase of the study
- Must be willing to abstain from eating grapefruit or drinking grapefruit juice for the treatment phase of the study

Exclusion Criteria:

- Any evidence of cardiovascular disease
- Acute diverticulitis or a history of greater than one episode
- Antibiotic use within 1 month prior to screening, except for prophylactic use
- Unexplained fever or weight loss of at least 10 pounds during the last 6 months
- Participation in any other clinical trial within the last month
