<b>Antenatal Unit</b>	3:00 – 8:00 pm Variable	Weekdays Saturday, Sunday
<i>Be a companion to mothers-to-be by providing recreational activities such as reading, playing board games, painting fingernails, scrapbooking, watching movies, etc.</i>		
<b>Auxiliary – The Food Connection</b>	Anytime between 3:00-7:00pm	Monday-Friday
<i>Assist staff in serving the visitors of this busy shop.</i>		
<b>Auxiliary Gift Shop</b>	9am – 3pm 1:00 – 5:00 pm Anytime between 3:30-8:00pm	Saturday Sunday Weekdays
<i>Stocking and pricing new merchandise, making balloon arrangements, straightening shelves, delivering flowers to patient rooms, changing displays, etc.</i>		
<b>Breastfeeding Clinic</b>	9:00am-11:30am	Saturday
<i>Greeting mothers as they arrive at the clinic, weigh the newborn babies; provide clerical support, i.e., assembling education materials, etc.</i>		
<b>Building Blocks</b>	3:00-5:30pm	Monday-Friday
<i>Interacting with children by reading stories, assisting them in art projects, rocking them (the younger ones), and being their friend. Two character references, and a signed medical assessment (form provided) is required, minimum age of 14, and maturity is essential. Additional training is mandatory prior to your first day.</i>		
<b>Central Supply</b>	3:30-6:30pm or 4:00-7:00pm	Monday -Friday
<i>Labeling items and helping put stock on the shelf.</i>		
<b>Emergency</b>	3:30-6:30pm or 4:00-7:00pm 9:00am – 3:00 am	Monday-Friday Saturday, Sunday
<i>Take patients to and from x-ray, stock rooms, provide blankets, water, etc., to patients, check with patients' families for any needs, assist staff with chart processing. <b>Must be at least 16 years of age.</b></i>		
<b>Pharmacy</b>	8:00am-12noon, 12noon-4:00pm	Saturday, Sunday
<i>Assist the staff by transporting medications to patient care areas, place doses back in correct places, some clerical support and general duties.</i>		
<b>Pre/Post Surgery</b>	3:30-6:30pm or 4:00-7:00pm	Monday-Friday
<i>Transport patients for dismissal. Organize patient belongings and deliver meal trays.</i>		

**Radiology** 4:00-7:00pm Monday, Thurs., Fri.  
8:00am-12:00noon Saturday  
*Retrieve and file x-ray film folders, answer telephone, general assistance to staff, performing errands, and assist with patient transport.*

**Registration** 3:00-6:00pm or 4:00-7:00pm Monday-Friday  
*Escort patient and family to patient room upon admission to the hospital.*

**Senior Diagnostic Center** 4:00-7:00pm Monday, Thursday  
*Assist with recreational activities, read newspaper to patients, writes notes, etc. **Must be at least 16 years of age.***

**Transportation** 4:00-7:00pm Monday-Friday  
8:00am-12n & 12n-4:00pm Saturday, Sunday  
*Make delivery runs to nursing floors; deliver central supply items, etc.*

**Surgery/Recovery** 4:00-7:00pm Monday-Friday  
*Stocking supplies, assisting staff in transporting patients to rooms, other errands as directed by staff. **Must be at least 16 years of age.***
