Medicare

If you meet certain income and resource limits, you may qualify for extra help from Medicare to pay the costs of Medicare prescription drug coverage.

- In 2014, you may qualify if you have up to \$17,505 in yearly income (\$23,595 for a married couple) and up to \$13,440 in resources (\$26,860 for a married couple).
- In 2014, drug costs for most people who qualify are no more than \$2.55 for each generic/\$6.35 for each brand-name covered drug.

NeedyMeds

NeedyMeds is a national non-profit organization that maintains a website of free information on programs that help people who can't afford medications and health care costs. All the information is accessible online, at no charge and without registration.

- NeedyMeds provides a free drug discount card that offers a discount of up to 80% at more than 63,000 pharmacies nationwide.
- Anyone can use the card regardless of income level or insurance status and no registration is required. The same card can be used by friends and family members to save on prescription drugs, over-the-counter drugs and medical supplies written on a prescription form, and pet prescription drugs purchased at a pharmacy.
