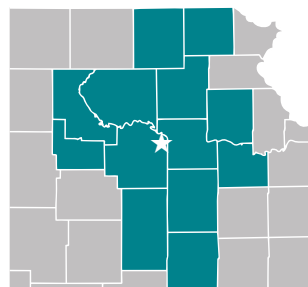
Community

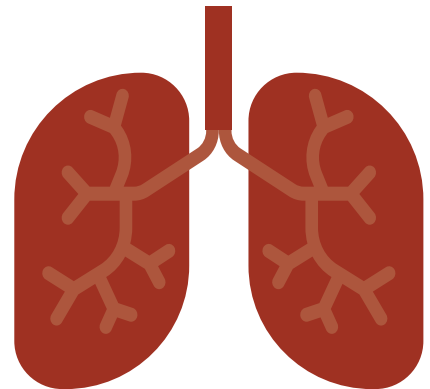

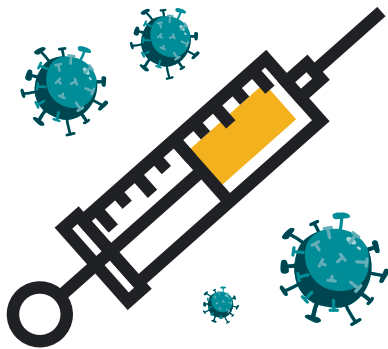
